













GRAFTON PACK 107 TECHNOLOGY AND PHOTO POLICY

Cub Scouts should not use electronic devices at meetings or events, unless the activity requires the use of them. An example of this would be using GPS or an app on a smartphone for geocaching.

We understand that many adults may need to take phone calls or check emails. There may also be other circumstances in which the use of an electronic device is necessary during Cub Scout events (an example would be taking photographs). Recognizing that the Scouts are influenced by the behavior of the adults around them, the use of electronic devices is discouraged at Scout meetings or events. We ask that if you need to use your phone during a meeting or event, that you please step out of the Scouts' view to do so.

Younger siblings of Scouts participating in meetings may use an electronic device to occupy them, given that it does not disturb the meeting.
